

## **Jud Little Ranch Covid-19 Policies and Procedures**

The Jud Little Ranch Horse Sale scheduled for June 13, 2020 at Noon CDST will allow in person bidding, as well as online bidding.

Due to the Covid-19 Virus, it is our intent to abide by all CDC and State of Oklahoma guidelines. Anyone with any compromised health issue is strongly encouraged to bid online through Superior. Potential Buyers will be allowed to attend the Jud Little Ranch Horse Sale in person, if they meet the following requirements:

- a. You are not feeling ill and have no symptoms of illness, such as, but not limited to, a fever, cough, sore throat, or shortness of breath.
- b. You do not have any underlying health issue(s) that would put your health and/or life at risk should you contract Covid-19.
- c. You agree to abide by the requirements posted online prior to the sale and as outlined below, as well as abiding by all of the signage posted on the Jud Little Ranch on the day of the sale.

Please be advised that when you come to the ranch office to obtain your bidder number, you will need to be wearing a mask. You will be given a mask, if you do not have one of your own, and will be asked to wear a mask to enter any indoor facility on the Jud Little Ranch, including but not limited to the ranch office, all barns, the covered stable areas, and the indoor riding arena where the auction will be conducted. As regards registration and check out, only 10 people will be allowed in the ranch office at any given time, so waiting outside will be necessary. This may slow the process of registration and check out. We ask for your patience as we try to be as efficient as possible under these conditions.

Chairs will be provided during the auction and will be set 6 feet apart. You are asked to not move the chairs, so that we may assure safe distance practices. We ask that all standing bidders also observe the 6-foot safe distancing practice during the auction.

There will be hand sanitizer available in the ranch office, at the auction arena, and at the outdoor bathroom facilities. We encourage everyone to use the hand sanitizer frequently and liberally.

If you believe you cannot abide by the above safe practice rules, we strongly request that you consider bidding online.

We will have additional security on the premises and at the above-mentioned areas helping us to monitor safe practices for all involved. We will have security cameras in the sale arena, the ranch office, and around the ranch property. We will use these to monitor behavior as well. We are hopeful that everyone will help us to maintain a safe environment for all in attendance!
